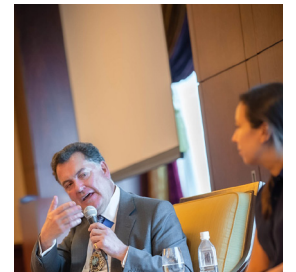

Diversity, Equity & Inclusion

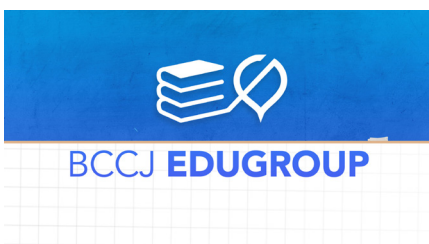



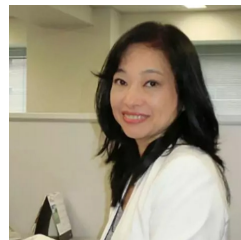
